



Go Kart Driver Instructions

OUR AIM IS FOR YOU TO HAVE A SAFE AND ENJOYABLE DAY

Prior to mounting the machine you will be given detailed instructions explaining the use of all controls, how to ride or dive safely, and how to avoid dangers, you will also be warned about the risks involved. Please read the following instruction very carefully before driving off.

INCORRECT USE OF MACHINE CAUSES DANGER THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS MUST BE STRICTLY OBSERVED:

1. Do not ride any machine if in doubt.
2. No riders under the age of 16 are allowed except with the approval of a parent or guardian and under a marshal's guidance.
3. Crash helmets must be worn at all times. Long hair should be tucked in or tied back. No scarves permitted.
4. Drivers must observe and obey marshal's flag; failure to do so will result in the driver being asked to leave the circuit.
Yellow: There is a danger ahead- slow down, No overtaking- be prepared to stop.
Black and White: Return to pits immediately- either for mechanical problems or persistent dangerous driving.
Red: All drivers must STOP immediately and await further instructions.
Chequered: End of race- slow down, cease overtaking and return to the pits.
5. Excessive speed and lack of control may cause accidents. Always drive within your limitations and control your speed.
6. In the event of a vehicle malfunction or accident, draw to the edge of the circuit and raise your arm. A marshal will attend to you.
7. Go Karting is a non-contact sport. Drivers who bump other karts will be removed from the circuit.
